



DRESS CODE POLICY

Standard of dress and general appearance will determine the privilege of members and their guests to use the course and facilities of NSW GC.

Enforcement of the dress code is the responsibility of staff.

Their determination is final and should be respectfully accepted without debate or further reference to other staff or directors that may be present at the time. This courtesy applies regardless of the attire in question having been previously worn at the club.

All golfers, including visitors, must report to the Golf Shop prior to hitting off or using the practice facilities.

MEN'S ATTIRE

Golf Course and Practice Facilities:

- All attire must be golf specific or similar
- Shirts must be collared and be tucked into belted pants or shorts
 - Socks must be white and visible above the shoe line
 - Shoes must be clean, soft spiked and golf specific

Clubhouse:

- Clean, dry, golf attire and smart casual wear are suitable after golf
- Collared dress shirts, dress shoes and trousers for evening functions and meetings
 - Jackets are encouraged for all events but are optional unless specified
 - Anything deemed appropriate by staff for the occasion or circumstance

Not acceptable:

- Anything deemed by staff as inappropriate
- Hats or golf caps are not permitted in the clubhouse
 - Untucked shirts
 - Denim, jeans or cargo pants



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WOMEN'S ATTIRE

Golf Course and Practice Facilities:

- Neat, clean and well-maintained golf specific apparel
- Tops and shirts designed to be worn outside bottom garments should be hip length
 - All tops and shirts must have a collar
- Shoes must be clean, soft spiked and golf specific

Clubhouse:

- Neat golfing attire is acceptable
- Clothing should be appropriate to the occasion

Not acceptable:

- Cargo, denim, tracksuits, hoodies or jeans style pants are not permitted at any time
 - Large logos or numbering
- Hats or golf caps are not permitted in the clubhouse
