LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf, and with any temporary local rules)

- 1. GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Those areas marked by white lines are "ground under repair". Relief may be taken under rule 25.
- 2. STAKED OR GUARDED TREES: If a shrub or tree which is protected by a tree guard or is staked, interferes with the player's stance or the area of his/her intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted. Note: The stakes are immovable obstructions.
- 3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION: The Works Compound (18th hole), the Rescue Helicopter Hangar and the adjacent retaining wall (5th hole), all rubberoc and gravel pathways and roads and any sections of green plastic matting installed to reduce wear on the course are immovable obstructions. Relief from "interference", as that term is defined in Rule 24-2a. may be taken under Rule 24-2b(i).
- 4. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE: The cobblestone road on the left hand side of the 5th fairway is an integral part of the course; the ball must be played as it lies or deemed unplayable.
- 5. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS: If a ball lies through the green and a fixed sprinkler head is on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played and intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, and the ball is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- 6. LATERAL WATER HAZARD: The margins of lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes. These stakes are immovable obstructions and are within the hazard.
- 7. LATERAL WATER HAZARD PROVISIONAL BALL: On the 6th hole, a provisional ball may be played for a ball that may be in or lost in a lateral water hazard. The ball may be played provisionally under any of the available options under Rule 26 or any other applicable Local Rule. If the original ball is found outside the hazard, the player must continue play with it. If a provisional ball is played and the original ball is in the lateral water hazard, the player may play the original ball as it lies or continue the provisional ball in play, but s/he may not proceed under Rule 26-1.
- 8. DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES: For all play, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is (in stroke play) 2 strokes, then second breach is disqualification, (in match play) loss of hole, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.
